Weston group receives 200K revitalization grant

WESTON — Rehabilitation projects in downtown Weston's Long Branch Cafe & Saloon and the Old Post Office recently received a big boost.

The Weston Area Development Association announced it received a \$200,000 Oregon Main Street Revitalization Grant to support the projects. WADA was among 27 recipients from across the state to receive grant funding.

In a press release, WADA President Trish Neal said the Long Branch — originally constructed as a mercantile in 1874 — needed rehabilitation work prior to a September 2021 fire. While she said it reopened a year later, the structure still needs restoration work identified before the blaze.

Constructed about 1895, Neal said the historic Old Post Office requires extensive restoration work. She said the funding will allow the owners to begin that process in order to save the building.

"This grant is the start of historic preservation work to be conducted in Weston's Historic Commercial Downtown District," Neal said.
